The first discharge of LPG from Ichthys LNG Project in Japan

~Diversification of Supply Source~

Astomos Energy Corporation announces the commencement of taking the LPG from Ichthys LNG Project operated by INPEX CORPORATION (hereinafter referred to as the "Ichthys LPG") and completion of the first discharge in Japan at KYUSHU L.P.G. FUKUSHIMA TERMINAL today.

Astomos Energy assures further safe and continuous LPG supply to Japan with diversified supply source by Ichthys LPG.

1. Brief description of Sales and Purchase Contract.

(1) Volume

LPG (Propane and Butane) lifted from Ichthys LNG Project which is handled by INPEX Trading, LTD.

FOB basis.

2. Ichthys LNG Project

Interest owned	INPEX (66.245%, Operator) ※, TOTAL (26%) ※, CPC (2.625%) , Tokyo Gas (1.575%) , Osaka Gas (1.2%) , Kansai Electric Power (1.2%) , JERA (0.735%) , Toho Gas (0.42%) ※ INPEX reached an agreement with TOTAL to acquire a portion (4%) of the participating interest held by TOTAL. Completion of the acquisition is subject to the fulfillment of certain conditions. The interest percentages outlined above denote the interest owned upon completion of the acquisition.
Outline	Ichthys LNG project is a project to produce and export LNG from Ichthys Gas-condensate Field (offshore Western Australia). Annual production and shipments from the onshore gas liquefaction plant (Darwin, Northern Territory of Australia) are scheduled to amount to approximately 8.9 million tons of LNG and 1.65 million tons of LPG, along with 100,000 barrels of condensate per day at peak.
